## **Privacy Policy**

- 1. When providing legal, mediation and advisory services, MPS Law (we, us) may collect and handle information that is personal, including sensitive information. MPS Law is committed to properly managing personal information in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) and the *Australian Privacy Principles* (**APP**). This commitment applies in addition to the duty of confidentiality that applies to us as legal practitioners. MPS Law also complies with the *Spam Act 2003* (Cth).
- When you access resources from our website, subscribe to receive communications, enquire about our services, or when you become a client of MPS Law, a record is made that includes your personal information. The type of personal that we collect will vary depending on the circumstances of collection and the kind of service that you request from us, but will typically include your name, email address and other contact details, information about your employer or organisation you represent, your professional details and any additional information that you provide to us or authorise us to collect as part of your interaction with MPS Law.
- 3. We generally collected personal information directly from you when you access information or resources from our website or when we interact with you. From time to time, we may collect personal information about you from other sources, such as the organisation you work for or are a member of.
- 4. The purposes for which MPS Law usually collects and uses personal information depends on the nature of your interaction with us, but may include: responding to requests for information; managing, planning and advertising services or resources; informing you of our activities; conducting evaluations of our services; other purposes as set out in the <u>Collection Notice</u>.   - c. the person to whom the personal information relates has given their consent for the information to be shared, or,
  - d. disclosure of personal information is for a secondary purpose where that secondary purpose is directly related to the primary purpose of collection.
